3. Registration

Registration for the Atlantic Challenge is now open!

Here is how to create your account and register:

Before you can register, you must create an account on

1. RAMP: <https://www.rampregistrations.com/login?v3=561d12a2>
- 1) Once you are logged into your new account. You will see a blue drop down menu on the left hand side saying "My Account Members", click this.
- 2) On the main screen, click the yellow "Add an Account Member" button and fill out the information.
- 3) Once you added your account member, select "Register" on the blue left hand side menu and click "Individual Competition Registration". This is where you will be able to register for the event itself.
- 4) Choose Season "2026 Boccia"
- 5) Choose a Competition "Boccia Competitions"
- 6) Select your account and double check that all the information is correct.
- 7) Choose Division "Boccia"
- 8) Select the Individual Event Category "Boccia"
- 9) Select the Event "Atlantic Boccia Challenge"
- 10) Complete the registration form

4. Classification

Classification will be available for players who are interested in moving into the competitive stream and want to better understand how the classification system works. At the Atlantic Boccia Challenge, athletes will receive a **preliminary classification only**.

A preliminary classification is required for any athlete competing in a sanctioned Boccia event for the first time, including Provincial and National Championships.

During this session, nationally certified classifiers will explain the full classification pathway and walk players through what typically happens during a formal assessment.
